I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition/Clinic involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, spinal cord injuries, trauma, pain suffering, or death (harm). I agree to release Tri-State Dressage Society and any recognizing entities, the officers, board members and volunteers of Tri-State Dressage Society, the Competition/Clinic and facility from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any harm to me or my horse and for any harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of Tri-State Dressage Society or the Competition/Clinic. I agree to expressly assume all risks of harm to my horse, or me including harm resulting from the negligence of Tri-State Dressage Society or the Competition/Clinic. I agree to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) Tri-State Dressage Society or the Competition/Clinic and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for harm to my horse, or me and for claims made by others for any harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition/Clinic. TSDS GENERAL SHOW RULES: Open Shows: TSDS Membership is not required to compete but are to be eligible for TSDS awards

Entries: Two ways to enter: 1) **BY MAIL** Fill out attached form (with all info and signatures) and mail with check (payable to TSDS) and coggins to Show Secretary listed above. Must be received by the Saturday before the show. 2) **ONLINE** at tristatedressagesociety.com , download the entry and upload or email the filled out version. TSDS Members may pay at check in at the show but non-members must mail check or contact show secretary wfor payment arrangements. TSDS will in the future offer the ability to enter and pay online with credit card. Late entries will be NR (non ribboned) rides. The test will not place or ribbon at this show but score will count for TSDS Yr End Awards if applicable.

Arena: warm up area is in covered sandy arena. Show rings in outdoor arena with good sand footing. Lungeing is not allowed in either ring. Designated lunging areas are provided. Training Test 2 and above will be in the large arena 20 x 60. Introductory and USEA in small 20 x 40. Western Dressage and Training 1 as ring allows. **Test Callers:** All tests may be called but rider is responsible for having that person available.

Classes: Fees are \$25 each and allowances given to rider riding more than one horse as set forth by USEF rules.. Scheduling is altered to facilitate pinning the classes in a prompt and organized manner. **Ride Times:** Posted Wednesday before show on our website.

Concessions will not be available on the show grounds. Hospitality coffee and/or water is available at the show office.

Show Awards: Ribbons 1st—6th place in each class. USDF divided Jr/Am/Open, USEA and Western Dressage classes divided Jr/Sr. Intro, Training and WD riders must compete in 3 classes to be eligible for show division championship. First Level and above USDF test riders must compete in 2 classes to be eligible for show division championship. **Attire:** Approved helmets and boots (paddock boots and half chaps) are required at all times by anyone when mounted on show grounds. Neat, conservative attire is requested; jackets are optional. Shirt must have a collar and sleeves.

Musical riders: are required to provide their music on a CD no less than one hour before for sound check.

Stabling: Stalls are available on show grounds for \$30 per night with initial bedding provided. Show management will assign stalls and stall cards posted. Any horse or tack occupying a stall without a stall card showing their assignment will be asked to move. Riders moving stall cards without prior agreement will be asked to leave. PLEASE HELP US FIGHT COST AND LEAVE STALL CLEAN!

Cancellation: rides will not be canceled due to wet weather but delayed in case of lightning.

Refund Policy: Before CD fees less office will be refunded upon request. After CD class fees only IF ride time slots can be filled.

Pet Policy: Dogs must be kept on a leash no longer than 6 ft and may not be tied anywhere on the show grounds or stabling area.

Facility address is Holly Hill Farm, 1296 Old Plain Dealing Road, Benton, LA 71006

Directions: From I-20 take I-220 Loop to exit 11 (Hwy 3) and go North to Benton, LA. At the second traffic light in Benton turn West over the tracks onto Old Plain Dealing Rd. Holly Hill is 3 miles on the right.

LATE ENTRIES = entries accepted after closing date and after ride times are started will be NR Non Ribboned rides meaning the test will be ridden and scored as usual and count toward TSDS year end awards but test will not be eligible for a placing or ribbon at this show.

TSDS Year End Awards: In order to be eligible the rider must be a TSDS member in good standing and compete in two TSDS club shows and have filled their volunteer hours. Then horse / rider pair scores are to be submitted for tabulation and awards. A minimum of five scores from a level are required (exception is musical rides which must be performed at two TSDS club shows). All scores from TSDS club shows, TSDS recognized shows, USDF rated shows and USEA events can be submitted. Form available for score submission on TSDS website.

Scores must be submitted on or before Dec 1. (Scores from TSDS shows and TSDS Recognized shows do not require a form as they are posted on our website but check for accuracy. All other scores must be submitted.) The horse does not have to be owned nor leased by the rider nor does the owner have to be a TSDS member. Please see website for detailed explanation or contact score tabulator.

TSDS Show Rules: Unless otherwise specified, TSDS shows are considered schooling shows and as such are not recognized by either USEF or USDF; however, the shows are conducted using those associations guidelines and rules. Submission of an entry is acknowledgement and agreement with the TSDS rules.

Online entries: ONLY TSDS Members in good standing may enter online and bring payment with them to office check in. We are doing this as courtesy until the Treasurer has our Ecommerce account set up to take credit card payments.
